



RESOLUTION NO. 23-0307-H1

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF ENNIS, TEXAS DECLARING UNOPPOSED CANDIDATES FOR MAYOR PRO TEM AT LARGE AND CITY COMMISSIONER WARD 2 TO BE ELECTED IN THE MAY 6, 2023 GENERAL ELECTION; CANCELLING THE GENERAL ELECTION FOR MAYOR PRO TEM AT LARGE AND CITY COMMISSIONER WARD 2; PROVIDING FOR POSTING OF THE RESOLUTION AT POLLING LOCATIONS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, A general election to be held on May 6, 2023 was ordered by the City of Ennis City Commission by Resolution No. 23-0207-H1 for the purpose of electing a Mayor Pro Tem At Large, a City Commissioner Ward 2 and a City Commissioner Ward 4; and

WHEREAS, the City Secretary has certified in writing that there is no proposition on the ballot, that no person has made a declaration of write-in candidacy, and that the candidates for Mayor Pro Tem At Large and City Commissioner Ward 2 on the ballot are unopposed for election to office; and

WHEREAS, under these circumstances, Texas Election Code Sections 2.052 and 2.053 authorizes the City Commission to declare the candidates elected to office and cancel the general election for Mayor Pro Tem At Large and for single member district Commissioner Ward 2; and

WHEREAS, a general election for single member district Commissioner Ward 4 will be held on May 6, 2023 and the Mayor Pro Tem At Large and the City Commissioner Ward 2 will appear on the ballot as 'unopposed'.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF ENNIS, TX:

SECTION 1: That the General Election for Mayor Pro Tem At Large and for City Commissioner for single member district Ward 2 are hereby canceled, and the city secretary is directed to cause a copy of this Resolution to be posted on Election Day at each polling place that would have been used for the stated general election.

SECTION 2: That the following candidates for Mayor Pro Tem At Large and for Commissioner Ward 2 are hereby unopposed in the May 6, 2023 General Election, are declared elected to office, subject to qualifications under state law and the home rule charter, and shall be issued a certificate of general municipal election following the time of the General Election canvass thereof:

- Jake Holland, Mayor Pro Tem
- Bruce Jones, City Commissioner Ward 2

SECTION 3: That the City Secretary is directed to cause a copy of this Resolution to be posted on election day at each polling place used, or would have been used, in the general election for a Mayor Pro Tem At Large and a Commissioner Ward 2.

SECTION 4: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its adoption.
